The first part of the GC3 or NCC2 requires the completing of a workplace inspection and the spotting of a range of hazards. You may wish to use these pictures to carry out a mock inspection. If you want to complete inspection sheets and send up to two in to us for review we can give you feedback on layout, depth and content.

Examine the three pictures provided and then on a GC3 Observation sheet log details of **five different hazards** which you can see from at least two of the main hazard groups (e.g. physical, chemical, ergonomic, biological, welfare etc). You could also note hazards which you could foresee from the activities undertaken in each area e.g. if there is high level storage at some time there will be some MH and over reaching). Complete the observation forms in the following format.
